# NOTICE OF RACE

## XXXII CARNIVAL SAILING INTERNATIONAL WEEK

The **CLUBE INTERNACIONAL DA MARINA DE VILAMOURA** will held the Carnival Sailing International Week, an ISAF Event and Olympic Classes World Ranking, from the 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> February 2006 in Vilamoura – Portugal for the following Classes:

**Optimist, Vaurien, 420, Snipe, Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Europe, 470, 49<sup>er</sup>, Hobie Cat 16, Dart 18 and Beneteau 25.**

### INTRODUCTION

The Regatta will be held off Vilamoura near Faro, in the southern coast of Portugal, one of the most suitable locations for sailing in Winter.

CIMAV organised high level regattas open to the major international sailing classes: the Star Class Worlds, the Star Class Sp. Europeans, the Snipe Jr. Europeans, two Iberian Snipe Championships, the Master Snipe Worlds, IYRU World Youth Championship, Soling Europeans, Soling Match Race Cup, Dragon Class Prince Henry Cup from 1994 to 2001, RM Europeans, Finn Europeans, Vaurien Worlds, 2001 Europe Class World Championship, Tornado Europeans 2002 and six Grade 2 Match Race Events (Algarve Cup, Women's Europeans and Land Rover Cup).

Vilamoura harbour is integrated in a vast top quality tourist resort with a wide range of hotels and accommodation to choose from.

There are cranes and travel lifts facilities available for rising and lowering boats, berths with floating jetties, boatyards and one loft for sail repair.

Besides the above mentioned, Vilamoura also offers the Casino, Restaurants and bars for all tastes, Discos, Banks and Exchange offices, shopping, etc.

The Faro International Airport is situated 20 Km far from the Vilamoura Marina.

From any point of Europe outside of the Iberian Peninsula stay on the Madrid motorway, follow to Seville, pick up the Huelva motorway until you find the motorway to Portugal (before Huelva), go through the new Guadiana bridge (which separates Portugal from Spain).

In Portugal follow the "Via do Infante" highway up to the crossroad Boliqueime-Vilamoura (approx. 60 Km).

Parking and mooring in the CIMAV will be free during the whole period of your stay.

If you wish to bring your boat sooner to Vilamoura, CIMAV will look after it during Winter.

## 1. RULES

The Carnival Sailing International Week will be governed by the “rules“ as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005 – 2008.

## 2. ENTRIES

The Regatta is Open and the entries must be send to the Organizing Authority – CIMAV – Clube Internacional da Marina de Vilamoura – 8125 – Vilamoura – Portugal – before 6 p.m. on 15<sup>th</sup> February.

1. Each competitor must register his entry at the Race Office until 11.00 a.m. on 25<sup>th</sup> February.
2. The entry fee shall be paid at Registration.
3. No kind of credit card is accepted.

## 5. SAILING LICENSES

All competitors must comply with the Rules of their National Authority concerning sailing licences.

## 6. SCHEDULE OF RACES

All Classes

The starting time for the 1<sup>st</sup> race will be not before 1.00 p.m. on 25<sup>th</sup> February. No more than 3 races per day will be sailed and the total number of races will be 7 (6 for the Optimist Class).

## 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Race Office between 6.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. on 24<sup>th</sup> February and 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. on 25<sup>th</sup> February.

## 8. COACH BOATS

- 9.1 Team leaders are permitted to use individual team support boats and to moor at the Club only if registered at the Race Office and shall conspicuously fly their national flag or clubs flag (min 40X50 cm).

9.2 In case of rescue operations, they must report to the Race Officers instructions.

## **10. PRIZES**

The prize given ceremonies will be at 7.00 on 27<sup>th</sup> February.

Prizes will be awarded to helmsmen and crewmembers, one for each ten-boat participant to the maximum of 5 per Class.

There will be packet lunches for the Optimist Class
